



Rules and Regulations

- 1) Age groups can be combined or separated at the director's discretion. If at least 3 participants in an age group, it will not be combined.
- 2) All Supreme and Grand Supreme cash and saving bonds awards are based on a minimum of 25 contestants entering a Supreme or Grand Supreme package.
- 3) The Supreme winner will have purchase a Supreme or Grand Supreme package, and have the highest combined Beauty, Mini Optionals, and top two (2) Photo Optionals. No Modeling or Talent scores will be used.
- 4) The Grand Supreme winner will have purchased a Grand Supreme package, and have the highest combined Beauty, Mini Optionals, top two (2) Photo Optionals, and one (1) Modeling Optional scores. No Talent scores will be used.
- 5) A contestant may not win a Supreme or Grand Supreme title at more than one (1) preliminary pageant. This **does not** include the Pageant Expo as this is a separate Cover Miss and Cover Boy Event or any double headers with other pageant systems.
- 6) We do not double crown. The participant will be awarded the highest title and a participation crown during their Divisional awards.
- 7) No participant may win more than three (3) Mini Optionals.
- 8) The Director can change prize package to an equal or greater value at any pageant.
- 9) Mall gift cards may be issued in lieu of cash or savings bonds at an equal or greater cash value.
- 10) Please note there was an error in our brochure. We originally planned to have one (1) overall Universal King / Queen and one (1) overall Directors Choice winner; however we will now have one (1) winner in each age group. As such, the prizes for Universal King / Queen and Directors Choice are a Crown (girls), Custom Sash, and \$150 Beauty Fees paid to State Finals! Bonds and roses will no longer be given to these titles. Sorry for any inconvenience.
- 11) Contestants and/or parents are not allowed to approach the judges at any time during the pageant.
- 12) Judges decisions are final and indisputable.
- 13) Outfit of Choice and Talent CDs, Photogenic pictures, and Composite Cards will be available at the left side of the stage immediately following the Crowning Ceremony. We will not be responsible for keeping or returning any items left behind.
- 14) Props are allowed for talent and Outfit of Choice competitions.
- 15) Hairdresser and/or make-up persons are allowed in the dressing room area, however please remember this is a community room, be cognizant of others space. H/M people are responsible for bringing their own table, chair, and extension cords, etc. When finished each H/M person is responsible for cleaning up their own area! Please make appointments on time, the Pageant will not wait for you.
- 16) Contestant numbers should be worn on the left side waist area if at all possible.
- 17) Contestants must be on time for scheduled competitions. We cannot delay competitions to wait for any Contestant. It is the responsibility of the chaperone to insure that the contestant is on time for each event. The pageant staff will not be responsible for informing contestants of times for scheduled competitions. Chaperones should follow the schedule of events listed in the program book and also listen for any changes that may be announced during competition. Any contestant



that is not on time for their scheduled competition will be allowed to compete as the last person in their division with a two-point (2) penalty per judge for that competition.

- 18) Any items left behind backstage or in the dressing room areas will be collected and retained for a period of ten days after the pageant! If these items are not claimed within the ten (10) day period we reserve the right to dispose of the property as we see fit. If you left something behind contact us and if you can prove the item is yours we will gladly return it to you! Any postage or handling fees are the responsibility of the parent and/or guardian who is claiming said property.
- 19) Only "Official" California Cover Miss and Cover Boy applications/information may be distributed at or during the pageant at any time unless expressly permitted by the state directors. Any such material if found will be removed.
- 20) Information on whom or how many are competing in any age group will not be disclosed.
- 21) No solicitors will be allowed at the event location unless specifically approved by the state directors
- 22) The use of any type of radio's, walkie-talkies, boom boxes, CD players, etc. is not allowed in the auditorium or in the dressing room areas.
- 23) Please do not leave valuable items unattended in the dressing areas or restrooms.
- 24) No video cameras or still photography allowed inside the auditorium. Anyone reported to the pageant staff for either of these will be asked to put their cameras away and/or removed from the auditorium. An official photographer and videographer will be available for anyone wishing to purchase photo packages or videos.
- 25) We would ask that everyone please wait before approaching the stage with your flowers, gifts, etc. until after pictures have been taken.
- 26) We reserve the right to disqualify any contestant or refuse entry to anyone in this or future pageant for poor sportsmanship or not honoring the duties of their title. Any and all legal fees incurred will be the responsibility of the contestant, parent(s) and/or guardians.
- 27) Division winners may not hold the same division title twice in consecutive years. Example: The title holder wins her division at age five (5) (Tiny Miss) she cannot return to compete again until she reaches age 7 or agrees to move up a division at age six (6) at which time she would compete as a Little Miss contestant.
- 28) Some mandatory events/appearances will be required of all State Royalty. Each new Royalty will be either emailed or by regular mail a welcome letter, which will include specific information regarding required appearances/events, etc. as soon as possible after the State pageant. All Royalty will be required to make two (2) appearances. In addition you are required to attend at least (3) three preliminary pageants of your choice. All state Royalty are also asked to attend our Christmas Party (Times and locations will be provided!)
- 29) Winners must fulfill their duties and will abide by all the rules and regulations set forth here and conduct themselves in a manner representing the high standards, which a Cover Miss or Cover Boy title demands.
- 30) Any Royalty that cannot abide by the rules & regulations set forth here and in their signed contract will be asked to relinquish their title within ten days and cover any and all expenses to award the title (at the state directors discretion) to the first runner-up (if available).
